The professorship "Development and Assistance in Early Childhood" deals in practice and research with fields of action in early childhood (0-3 years) in youth welfare, with particular attention to diversity and heterogeneity. A focus is on development in early childhood, especially for children in risk situations, and work with parents that is geared towards the child's well-being. Another focus is on early assistance and its interdisciplinary networking with relevant actors, including early childhood education, upbringing and care facilities.

The applicant is expected to have a sound knowledge of current discourses on the above-mentioned topics from a (social) educational and psychological perspective. In addition, we expect knowledge and experience as well as research in the aforementioned subject areas and with theory-practice transfer.

Professional profile: Completed studies, preferably in social work, educational science, psychology or comparable courses of study. A qualified doctorate is a prerequisite, preferably related to the advertised teaching area.
