We are looking for a person with a proven track record in theory and practice and a graduate degree in architecture, urban development, urban planning, urban design or related fields. Excellent scientific competences in the subject area, proven by a relevant doctorate or doctorate-adequate achievements, as well as pedagogical skills and subject related experiences are required for this appointment.

The position holder is expected to represent the field of urban planning in all programmes taught in the department, especially teaching and research in the bachelor and master programmes "Architecture" and "Urban Planning" as well as in the master programmes "Urban Agglomerations" and "Advanced Architecture", which are being taught in English, and in the master programme "Environmental Management and Urban Planning in Metropolitan Areas" (a cooperative programme with the Rhine-Main University of Applied Sciences and the Geisenheim University of Applied Sciences). Teaching will include basic education in urban planning, in-depth theory- and practice-related elective courses and projects, as well as the supervision of final theses

In addition to the spatial, social, inter- and transdisciplinary as well as organisational settings of planning and participation processes, the subject area includes the implementation at local, regional and national reference level. Applicants are expected to design and deliver innovative contributions to urban research and planning theory as well to the methodological challenges of planning and spatial development, with a focus on theory and methods.
